We also offer a **Foundation Degree** option alongside top-class undergraduate and postgraduate degrees across a range of subjects.

Our Dual Career programme is designed to support players who want to succeed at sport and in their studies. Scholarships are available to players who have shown potential to do well academically and athletically.

Our Student Performance Sport Programmes for those competing at the highest level of British Universities & Colleges Sport (BUCS), are underpinned by expert support services including highly-qualified coaches, physiotherapy, sports psychology, sports massage and strength and conditioning.

The University is the host to Team Bath Netball's National Super League club and, as such, provides one of the best holistic playing and training environments in the country. Players like Sophie Drakeford-Lewis and Imogen Allison have recently graduated as students from Bath and have joined more than 150 players who have come through our pathway and onto international honours.

In an average year our club has five teams, around 200 members and we play at the highest level of University sport. The University of Bath has one of the strongest employability profiles in the UK with links to over 4000 employers.

Facilities

Our netball performance programme is based at the £35 million Team Bath Sports Training Village and facilities include:

- 2 large sprung-wood sports halls
- A large, well-equipped gym spread across three floors
- Studios for fitness classes
- 8 indoor and 10 outdoor tennis courts (hard and clay)
- Indoor and outdoor athletics track
- Indoor throws & jumps hall
- A 50m swimming pool
- Hockey, rugby and football pitches
- A 3G training strip
- A traditional Japanese martial arts dojo
- Physio and sport science services centre
